Singapore is a major tech hub. Eighty of the top 100 tech firms have operations there[3]. One of the more recent arrivals is the formerly UK-based, Dyson company, which has moved its headquarters to the city-state. The US-China trade war has helped make it an even more attractive destination for investors.

It has a government-led initiative called "Smart **Nation Singapore**", whose sole aim is to develop a Digital Economy, Digital Government and Digital Society. It is primarily focusing on health, transport, urban solutions, finance, and education.

Launched in August 2019, the app from the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore, IPOS Go, means you can file a trade mark application in just 10 minutes at a reduced cost too! So, what tech advances will you experience when you go to Singapore?
